SIMPLIFIED PROCESS TO SELECT FOREIGN VISITING PROFESSORS
UNIVERSIDADE FEDERAL DE MATO GROSSO DO SUL

The Fundação Universidade Federal de Mato Grosso do Sul (UFMS), through the Office for Research and Graduate Programs (PROPP), invites proposals for the simplified selection process to hire **Foreign Visiting Professors/Researchers**, in the terms of the Law 8,475/1993, and the terms and conditions herein described.

1. GOAL

1.1 To hire 20 (twenty) well-qualified foreign professors/researchers, in the areas described in the annex of this call, for teaching and developing scientific research at the UFMS Academic Units (Institutes/Faculties/Schools/Campuses) that offer graduate programs. This hiring program aims at strengthening the graduate programs and research groups of the UFMS.

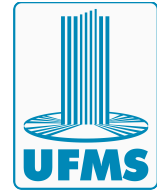

3. REQUIREMENTS

3.1. Applicants should demonstrate excellence in research and professional experience in the research areas of the research groups and graduate programs of the UFMS Academic Unit that they apply.

3.2 Applicants will be required to teach at both undergraduate and graduate levels, advise students, and engage in research development, with the overarching goal of increasing the UFMS scientific profile.



3.3. According to the Law 8,745/1993, applicants must have held a doctoral degree for at least two years and demonstrated excellence in research, preferably with important publications in the last five years.

4. APPLICATION

4.1. Applicants are required to submit the documents listed in Item 4.2 to the e-mail address of the UFMS Academic Unit of interest (listed in the annex), with a copy to visiting@ufms.br, by February 10, 2018.

4.2. Documents to submit with the application:

- a) *curriculum vitae*;
- b) certificate of the doctoral degree;
- c) motivation letter;
- d) research project;
- e) work plan with the research areas of interest and planned activities; and
- f) copy of the passport.

4.3. After processing the application, the UFMS Academic Unit must recommend or not an applicant for hiring by sending to PROPP the documents listed below:

- a) In case of recommending an applicant for hiring, the Academic Unit must send a letter indicating the relevance of the research project and work plan to the research areas of the graduate programs in which the applicant will work on. Also, the letter must indicate the teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels, supervising, and research activities the applicant will be involved;
- b) In case of not recommending an applicant for hiring, the Academic Unit must send a letter indicating the reasons for rejecting the application;
- c) Official resolution of the UFMS Academic Unit recommending or not recommending the hiring; and
- d) Table 2 filled in with the corresponding scores of the scientific production of the applicant, according to his/her *curriculum vitae*.

5. APPLICATION EVALUATION CRITERIA

5.1. The application will be accepted for consideration by a committee, with members formally nominated by the Director of the Academic Unit, that will check all the prerequisites listed in this call for applications and evaluate the merit of the work plan and its alignment to the research areas chosen by the candidate.

5.2. After the application is accepted for consideration, the research project will be evaluated and scored following the criteria described in Table 1. Only proposals accepted for consideration will be evaluated in this second step.

5.3. Applications accepted for consideration will be sorted in decreasing order of the average scores, computed as follows: the research project score times 0.4 plus the candidate productivity score, given by Table 2, times weight 0.6; the previous sum should be normalized considering 300.0 points equivalent to the average score 10.0. Only the proposals with average greater than or equal to 6.0 may be selected. At most two proposals will be selected for an Academic Unit.

6. COMPENSATION

6.1. The salary of the hired candidate will correspond to that of a Titular Professor (with a doctoral degree, 40-hour appointment, and Exclusive Dedication), according to the Law 12,772/2012, with the salary amount specified in Table 3. Food aid benefits are not taxable, but Income tax and Social Security will be withheld from the salary.

7. CONTRACT DURATION AND EXTENSION

7.1. The duration of the contract is at most 24 (twenty-four) months, with possible extension for another maximum of 24-month period.

7.2. The contract extension may be granted after the evaluation by PROPP-UFMS of the annual reports describing all developed activities, taking into account the initial work plan. The contract extension will be subject to budget availability at UFMS for this program.

7.3. The annual reports of the hired candidate must be approved by his/her Academic Unit before the hired candidate can be considered for an extension.

7.4. An extension request with a new work plan approved by the Academic Unit must be sent to PROPP at least 60 calendar days before the expiration date.

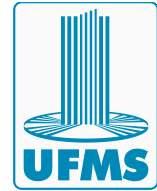
8. GENERAL CONDITIONS

8.1. Administrative appeals shall be filed, by sending an email to visiting@ufms.br, within the deadlines described in the calendar of events and must present counterarguments for the application denial. PROPP-UFMS will send an e-mail message to the candidate acknowledging the receipt of the appeal.

8.2. UFMS will disseminate this call via its website, national and international networks, as well as through the platforms of official funding agencies.

8.3. By participating in this simplified selection process, the applicants agree with all terms and conditions presented in this call for applications and all applicable law requirements.

8.4. To be eligible for the position, the applicant must not have been employed or contracted by the Brazilian government in the previous 24 (twenty-four) months before the beginning of its appointment, as required by the Law 8,745/1993.



8.5. To be hired, a candidate must present, by the signing day of his/her contract, a Brazilian permanent resident visa or a temporary visa for scientist, researcher, professor, technician, or other category professional, under the regime of contract with the Brazilian government and according to the Law 6,815/1980.

8.6. To be hired, a candidate cannot be an active employee of the direct or indirect administration of the Union, the States, the Federal District, and the Municipalities, as well as employee of its subsidiaries and controlled companies, according to article 6 of the Law 8.745/1993.

8.7. Contract will be terminated, with no rights to extra payments, after the duration, or if a notice of termination is given by the hired professor. In case of a contract termination initiated by UFMS, indemnity is due according to the Law 10,667/2003.

8.9. Candidates must confirm, by sending an email to visiting@ufms.br, their intention to accept the position within 30 days of their acceptance notification.

8.10. This call is valid to November 6th, 2018, with possible renewal according to decision of UFMS Rector.

8.11. Issues not covered in this call for applications will be resolved by PROPP-UFMS and PROGEP-UFMS.
